
Scholarship Policy

Any Scholarship offered by Orange International College is subject to the following Scholarship Terms and Condition.

Orange International College reserves the right to make minor amendments to these terms and conditions without prior notice.

Definitions:

Full time International Students: means a student who undertakes a full-time study load on International Student Visa.

Package Course: Multiple course combined in a Package. For Example, Certificate I in EAL (Access), Certificate II in EAL (Access), Certificate III in EAL (Access) and Certificate IV in EAL (Further Studies) to form a Package Course of four courses combined together.

Scholarship Course Offer within a Package Course: The course offer to which the scholarship has been applied as per the Letter of Offer and Student Agreement within the Package Course.

Conditions:

Commencement:

You must commence the package courses as per the commencement date mentioned on Letter of Offer and Student Agreement for each course. Orange International College may cancel your scholarship on failure to commence each course in package as per the Letter of Offer and Student Agreement.

Scholarship will be granted to different courses in the Package Offer as per the details provided in Letter of Offer and Payment Plan.

Deferral, Suspension & Cancellation:

If course commencement is deferred, Orange International College may cancel your scholarship.

If you are granted a Suspension from your course by the Orange International College on Compassionate or compelling Circumstances, your scholarship will be suspended for the duration of the suspension. However, to resume the scholarship, you should ensure to make the payments as per the Payment Plan during the duration of the Suspension. Failure to make payments during the suspension period may lead the college to cancel your scholarship.

The College can defer or suspend the enrolment of the student on the Grounds of:

- Compassionate or compelling circumstances
- Misbehaviour by the student.

Please note if your Course is Suspended on the Grounds of Misbehaviour by the student, the college holds the right to cancel your scholarship.

Duration:

Unless otherwise specified in your scholarship offer. The scholarship will be granted to the Full Time International Student and it will be eligible over the duration of the course.

Payment on Time:

Orange International College may cancel your scholarship on failure to pay your tuition fees on time as the Payment Plan issued to you at the time of enrolment. You can request the copy of the Payment Plan by filling General Request Form and submitting it to Student Supports Teams and/or Reception.

Change of Course/Course Provider:

If you wish to change your course at Orange International College, your current scholarship will be cancelled by the college and you may be eligible for different scholarship offered by the college at the time of enrolment.

The college will cancel your scholarship in the event you decide to transfer to other college. College will also demand the overdue fees and it will not be adjusted by the scholarship amount.

Misleading Information:

If you have provided false or misleading information or do not adhere to the terms and conditions of your scholarship, and as a result you were awarded or continued to receive the scholarship, the scholarship may cease and you may be required to repay any scholarship benefits to which you are not entitled to within 14 days of being requested to do so by the Orange International College.

Complaints & Appeals:
